December 15th 1:15 - 4:15 7-12 grade in the Drama Room. (This is a half day of school.)

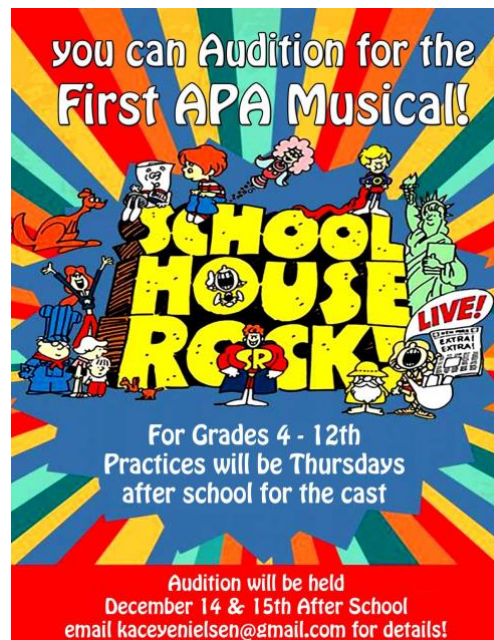
Rehearsals will start after Christmas break on Thursdays from 2:30 - 4:30 p.m.
