Welcome our New Athletic Director: Dave Bliss

Dave Bliss is our new Athletic Director at American Preparatory Academy – Las Vegas. He grew up in upstate New York and attended Cornell University, where he received his BS in Economics and his MBA in Marketing. Upon graduating from Cornell University in 1967, Bliss joined the U.S. Army and was assigned to the U.S.M.A. at West Point, N.Y., where he coached under college basketball icon, Bob Knight. Upon Knight taking Bliss to Indiana University, Dave's career path took a definite "coaching turn." The success of the Indiana teams allowed Dave to receive his first head coaching position at the University of Oklahoma. From OU, he went on to coach at Southern Methodist University, the University of New Mexico, and Baylor University. Most recently, Dave has served as Athletic Director and Basketball Coach at Allen Academy (Bryan, TX), Southwestern Christian (OKC, OK) and Calvary Chapel Christian School (LV, NV). Coach Bliss has been married to Claudia for 40 years and they have three children – Robert, married with two grand-daughters and a lawyer in Denver; Berkeley, married with grand-daughter and grand-son living in South Carolina; and Jeffrey – a graduate student at New York University's Film School. Dave is excited about APA's athletic future and being a member of one of Las Vegas's "best kept secrets."
