All School News

First Day Drop off: Starting at 7:30AM

Here at APA on the first day of school ALL students will be dropped off at the playground curb. However, if you have a Kindergartner you may park your car AT **8:15** and walk them into school. Please make sure to drop off the rest of your students at the curb first. This will only be allowed with parents who have a Kindergartner on the **1st day of school**.

If you **ONLY** have secondary students you may drop them off at the front entrance of the school. Those with elementary students in the car will NOT be allowed to drop any students off at the front entrance.

Please be mindful and patient with each other and staff. There are many new students who have not participated in our drop off procedures. This is a great opportunity to show off the builder spirit at APA. Make sure to get those 1st day of school pictures and goodbye hugs at home **BEFORE** dropping off your students.

Carpool Pick Up

On Monday (20th) and Tuesday (21st) EXPECT longer carpool lines. Pickup times on those days are as followed: **1st dismissal: 3:05 pm, 2nd dismissal: 3:30 pm, and 3rd dismissal: 3:50 pm.**

Students will be kept in their classrooms until their designated pick up time. Only come during your carpool dismissal, you will be asked to get back in line if it is not your dismissal. Please ensure to have your Carpool Tag visible for our staff.

Once again, please be mindful and patient with each other and staff.

Wednesday (22nd) carpool pick up times will be: **1st dismissal: 2:05, 2nd dismissal: 2:20 pm, and 3rd dismissal: 2:35 pm**

Students will ONLY be released to those cars with a carpool tag. If you have not picked up a carpool tag you MUST come into the school to get one between 8:30am and 2:00pm on MONDAY. **This is required by all parents.**

Walking Pass

If your student would like to walk home from school, parents must come into the school between 8:30am-2:00pm to fill out the walking pass form. Parents have to show proof of residency or other workplace that is within a mile of the school to be granted a walking pass.

Bus Pass

Any parents sending their students home on a bus for after school programs, **MUST** let the office know who will be picking up their child.

School Lunch

As a reminder, American Prep does not provide or sell school lunches. Our student store will **NOT** be open this week. Please ensure your student brings a healthy adequate lunch every day.

Fingerprinting

Fingerprinting events will be held at the school on August 21st (5:00 - 7: 00 pm) & August 22nd (6:00 – 7:00pm). Many of you have signed up to get this done, **THANK YOU**. We will be having walk in slots available both nights for those who were not able to sign up. The recent legislature passed a law requiring fingerprinting if you plan on being a regular volunteer (volunteering 4 or more times a month or attending culminating events/field trips).

Unfortunately, if you have recently been fingerprinted with another school or company, you are still required to be fingerprinted with APA. Fingerprinting results cannot be shared between agencies and organizations. The only exceptions are for those holding a current and valid Nevada Department of Education license. We apologize for the inconvenience!
